- We almost contacted the local meteorologist because of the severe intensity of our brainstorming:
 - Could our community offer home visits (by trained staff, volunteers, students) to fallers referred by:
 - Tri-State ambulance, where RNs do a phone follow-up to people assisted by Tri-State and who have consented to have their fall recorded in their medical records.
 - Epic medical records of both hospitals of people who confirmed they fell during the past year at their Annual Medicare Wellness Visit.
 - Fire and Police who assist older folks
 - Collaborating with Home Care agencies, OTs, PTs, Eye Doctors, Caregivers, etc. to identify older people receptive to a home visit/home safety check.
 - Can we implement a plan to educate patients and community members prior to a fall with specific strategies for targeted audiences (e.g. caregivers, adult children of older people, Strong Seniors, Swing into Shape, Tai Chi, Yoga, PTs, OTs, pharmacists, etc.)
 - Should we pilot an educational project (with prizes and giveaways) in a local store/e.g. grocery, pharmacy, medical equipment) where people would stop at multiple locations in the store to learn more about strength and balance exercises, home fall hazards, medication management, etc.
 - How will we grow Fall Prevention Awareness Day during 2017?
 - How can we enhance <u>www.lacrossestopfalls.org</u> website

Maybe incorporate short educational videos on falls prevention to show in medical waiting rooms, pharmacies, service centers
